


KNOT ROUND MIRROR | WALL INSTALLATION

- 3. For a wall made of load bearing material, pre-drill two 1/8in size holes on the marks. To ensure a smooth installation, use a screw driver to insert, then remove the screws
- 4. Fit the mirror knots (A) over the predrilled hole (B) on the wall, and use a flat head screw driver on wood screws (C) to secure the mirror.

WARNING:

DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE SCREWS - If screws are too tight, the wood knots may snap. DO NOT USE A POWER DRILL ON SCREWS

- 5. For wall made of non-load bearing material, pre-drill two 5/16in size hole on the mark for provided anchors.
- 6. Insert the anchor (D) into the predrilled hole (B), then fit the mirror knot (A) over the hole on the wall, and use wood screws (E) to secure the mirror to the wall.

WARNING:

DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE SCREWS - If screws are too tight, the wood knots may snap. DO NOT USE A POWER DRILL ON SCREWS
