

ROLL & HILL LAUNCHES ORBIT, DESIGNED BY JAMIE GRAY OF MATTER, ALONG WITH EXTENSIONS OF THE CHAMBER AND LAFAYETTE COLLECTIONS



New York, NY – Today Brooklyn-based lighting and furniture company Roll & Hill launched Orbit, a furniture collection designed by Jamie Gray, the designer, curator, and founder of New York design gallery, Matter. Orbit is the product of Gray's interest in 20th-century French modernism, a distillation of a period in design interpreted from a contemporary perspective.

The collection includes a coffee table and stool that capture the essence of French modernism both formally and materially. With a focus on the balance of form and function for this collection, Gray interpreted the feeling he gets when looking at work from this region and era into these pieces. By refining the ideas of this place and time in history, Gray arrived at the elliptical leg

motif carried throughout the designs. "An orbit is an elliptical revolution and that's how the name came to be," said Gray.

The collection is available in ebonized oak, hard maple, white oak, and black walnut. Prices for the stool range from \$760 - \$1,080 and for the coffee table from \$2,540 - \$3,510.

Roll & Hill has also launched new Chamber benches and a new Lafayette credenza, as extensions of these existing collections. The Chamber bench is one of a series of pieces originally designed by Post Company for Inness, a Hudson Valley country resort by tastemaker Taavo Somer that takes all of its cues from the surrounding landscape. Stable and understated, Chamber is founded in the foundational concepts of simplicity, utility, and clarity of construction. Three new benches sized at 48", 60", and 96" are added to the collection in hard maple, white oak, and black walnut finishes with prices ranging from \$2,180 - \$7,120.

In the Lafayette collection, a series of furniture that references steamer trunks and campaign furniture with cabinets that carry the same tradition of encapsulating personal items for safekeeping, Roll & Hill adds a credenza in hard maple, white oak, and black walnut finishes. Prices range from \$13,800 - \$14,200.

All pieces are currently on view in the Roll & Hill showroom in New York City's SoHo neighborhood.

Based in New York since 1998 and born in Los Angeles, California, his work is influenced by both the warm modernism of the west coast and the elegance of the east.
