## **ROLL & HILL LAUNCHES BODEN BY DAVID WEEKS**



**New York, NY –** On May 12, Brooklyn-based lighting and furniture company Roll & Hill will launch Boden – a collection of sculptural lighting fixtures crafted by the multidisciplinary designer David Weeks. David is recognized internationally for his sculptural and minimalist lighting, his process of discovery and experimentation, and the open-ended process between materials and scales that dictate the final form of his designs.

Boden is David's latest collection. Designed to be hung individually or in a group, he defines this collection as - refined, elegant, efficient, stripped down, and honest. The core of David's collection is the sleek design that allows for versatility in its potential applications. Each light fixture can exist easily as a single piece, a repeating architectural element, or hung in a group as a focal point.

This is Roll & Hill's first collaboration with David Weeks. "Roll & Hill is a company whose scale and ownership allow for meaningful relationships with manufacturers and has proven its commitment to the designer's vision. It's an opportunity to bring more designs to market with a partner that is cut from the same cloth as the designers themselves," David explains.

The collection consists of four pieces – a desk lamp, a wall sconce, a horizontal chandelier with two or four lights, and a vertical chandelier with six light fixtures. The *Boden* fixtures come in polished brass and each shade is made from a cut of tubing. The collection is currently priced between **TK**. 120v or 240v.
